A sustainable way forward – Haringey's Sustainable Community Strategy and the Local Area Agreement

Tackling local issues means working together. That is the purpose of the Haringey Strategic Partnership, which brings together the council, public agencies, community groups and businesses to plan a better future.

Following wide and extensive consultation the Haringey Strategic Partnership has agreed Haringey's Sustainable Community Strategy – "a sustainable way forward" which sets out the vision and direction for Haringey until 2016. Alongside this, the Local Area Agreement was developed. This agreement focuses on some of the most pressing issues facing Haringey such as unemployment, poor housing conditions, health inequalities and low educational attainment.

Monitoring progress

The Sustainable Community Strategy and Local Area Agreement will be monitored to check that we are making progress. We have developed a range of targets and milestones that will help us do this.
